STEPS TO A STRONGER LIBRARY

1. FACILITY

Focus on how to best cost effectively utilize existing space and staff to enhance patron experience.

2. COLLECTION

Analyze collection use and performance with benchmark and peer library comparisons to maximize circulation and optimize budget.

3. TECHNOLOGY

Review technology employed for patron service and staff efficiency to identify cost-saving opportunities and the role of emerging technology.

4. PROGRAMS

Evaluate current library programs using an effort/impact analysis.

5. MARKETING

Analyze population demographics to target user and non-user audiences and ensure marketing plans, digital and offline communications are relevant.

6. STAFFING

Map existing staffing plans with best practices to evaluate gaps and opportunities for workforce development.

7. OUTREACH

Review breadth and depth of community engagement initiatives, including partnerships, advocacy groups and volunteers.
